More than 500 abstracts have been submitted and have been reviewed by the Program Committee (PC). The Notification of Acceptance has been sent to all authors.

As in previous CHEP Conference, we will give special emphasis to the poster sessions. We plan to have two poster sessions with at least 1 hour allocated in the morning parts of the conference program. Each poster will be assigned to one of the two sessions and the authors will be required to attend one of the session(s).

Early Registration

The early registration deadline is 31 August 2010. The Conference fees are TWD 12,800 before and TWD 14,400 after 31 August 2010. Those prices include full conference participation, Welcome Reception, Lunches and Coffee Breaks, and Banquet.

Student Support

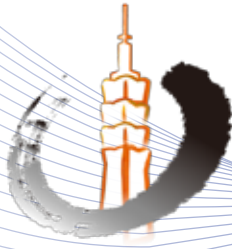
We are happy to announce that the deadline for applying Student Support has been extended to **31 July 2010**.
