

The EU-IndiaGrid Project

The principal goal of EU-IndiaGrid is to support interconnection between the most relevant European Grid infrastructure (EGEE) and the Indian Grids, to build a common infrastructure available to support data processing for e-Science application areas where strong collaborations already exist between Europe and India.

The project, comprising five European research and industrial partners from the UK and Italy, and six Indian research and governmental institutions throughout the country (specifically in Bangalore, Kolkata, Mumbai, New Delhi, and Pune), is a landmark in scientific collaboration between the EU and India.

EU-IndiaGrid started on October 1st 2006.

We will present the current status and perspectives of the project, and discuss ideas for expanded collaborations.
